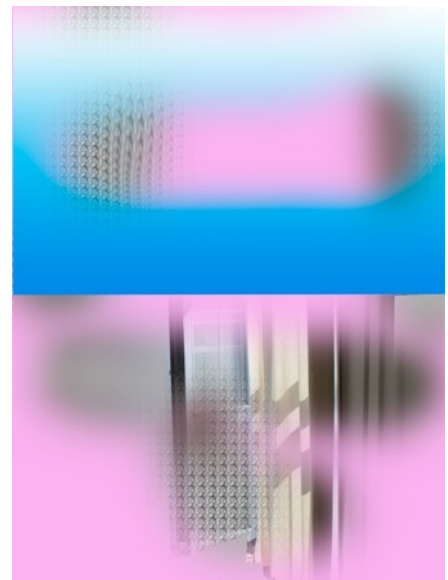


**ANDREY BOGUSH**

**PROPOSALS**

**11/12/2015 – 24/01/2016**

Proposals – is a series of works created by a young artist Andrey Bogush in 2015. It is an endless project featuring the current moment of life.



Andrey cannot imagine himself as an artist without a computer or digital camera. His art practice lays on the computer and digital plane. He works with a photograph which he transforms into something new. After this, it is not a photograph anymore. It does not turn into a collage. His artworks are something that resembles both sculpture and image at the same time.

“I take an image, which I made and then put layers on it. Change it. Transform it many times. My works are about surfaces and references. It is more about works themselves than about a concept. And it is more negative field than positive.”

The artworks of Andrey Bogush were exhibited at the Tate gallery in London, at galleries of Zurich and Milan, in such museums as the Kunsthalle, the Einar Jonsson Museum in Helsinki and Reykjavik. Besides, his works were selected to present advertising campaign of Prada SS in 2015. Now Andrey is ready to show his artworks in Russia.

Andrey Bogush will hold his very first solo exhibition in Russia at Osnova gallery.
